The **HSPT®** is a comprehensive placement test for eighth graders, which is published in two forms: the **Closed Form** and the **Open Form**.

Closed HSPT®

Last year, more than 100,000 students took the Closed HSPT®, which boasts high predictive validity with other national high school tests and college entrance exams. To maintain test security, the Closed HSPT® is revised each year.

The Closed HSPT® is available only as part of a lease/score program. Schools who lease the Closed HSPT® materials will receive the standard scoring service at no additional cost. Additional scoring services include optional local tests, Performance Profiles, Individual and Group Item Analysis Reports, student address services, and various reports for alternate groups.

The Closed HSPT® provides national normative measures in the following cognitive and basic skills areas: verbal and quantitative skills, reading, mathematics, and language. Cognitive skills quotients (CSQs), standard scores, national and local percentiles, as well as grade equivalents are standard features of Closed HSPT® reports.

To preview the Closed HSPT®, a school may purchase the Closed HSPT® Sample Set, which includes a Manual of Directions, test booklet, answer sheet, HSPT® Interpretive Manual, HSPT® Technical Supplement and Validity Studies, an optional test, Student Score Report, and sample reports.

Closed HSPT® Standard Scoring Service

- **Alphabetical List Reports** organize students in alphabetical order and provide cognitive skills quotients (CSQs), standard scores, national and local percentiles, as well as their grade equivalents for the basic skills subtests—reading, mathematics, and language (two copies).
- **Group Summary Statistical Reports** summarize overall group performance on all subtests and overall group performance on each subtest (two copies).
- **Rank-Order List Reports** arrange students from high to low based on their composite scores (two copies).
- **Pressure-Sensitive Labels** show each student's cognitive skills quotient (CSQ), standard scores, national and local percentiles, as well as grade equivalents for basic skills subtests—reading, mathematics, and language (one per student).
- The **HSPT® Interpretive Manual** is included with a school's reports. It is a guide to understanding HSPT® scores and drawing conclusions about student performance.
- **National Percentile Group Summary Results Report** allows schools to look at three different subpopulations of their testing groups and compare their performance to the national averages of up to nine different scores. A horizontal line indicates where the performance of a testing group would match the national average (one copy).

Open HSPT®

The **Open HSPT®** is available for school purchase. An earlier edition of the **Closed HSPT®**, it is scored locally with the **Open HSPT® School Scoring Kit** which includes norm tables. The **Open HSPT®** provides national normative measures in the following cognitive and basic skills areas: verbal and quantitative skills, reading, mathematics, and language. It is available in large print. Schools can also purchase an optional test in the area of science.

An **Open HSPT® Sample Set** provides a preview of this placement test to determine if it is suitable to a school's program. Each Sample Set includes a Manual of Directions, a test booklet, the HSPT® Interpretive Manual, the HSPT® Technical Supplement and Validity Studies, optional test, and Student Score Report.
